



SKIJOR FRIENDLY TRAILS

Certain restrictions may apply to these trails that may limit or even prevent skijoring. Permissions and restrictions can change at any time and without notice. It is your responsibility to know if such restrictions exist. Be aware on multi-use trails; traffic such as horses, dog walking/off-leash dogs, snowshoeing, and snowmobiling may create hazardous conditions. Determine the best time and days for using these trails.

Becker Trail	Hwy 10 to Becker, turn north on Sherburne County Road 23, just past golf course on the left side (look for "City Park" sign). Go to horse trailer parking lot. Trail goes into woods on the right side of the parking lot.	Sled, Skijoring, Cart & ATVs (with dog only) are allowed on trails. Shared trail with horses	26 miles
Bunker Hills-ACP	Hanson Blvd, 3/4 mile north of Main Street in Coon Rapids. Use Park entrance on east side of Hanson.	Only approved for winter training (no bikes or carts). Still being developed. 3 loops total.	1/2 mile, 2, and 4 miles

Crow-Hassan Park Reserve-TRPD	Located west of Rogers on Sylvan Lake Road. From I-94, take the Rogers exit and go south through Rogers to the T-intersection. Turn right on County Road 116 and go to County Road 203. Turn left and follow 203 to the park entrance. Phone: (763) 428-2765 (Winter Trailhead). For Eastman Nature Center, take County Road 81 to County Rd. 121, turn north and go to Elm Creek Road. Turn right and follow the road to the nature center.	Snowmobile trail open for dog sledding & skijoring on weekdays during daylight hours 5 am to 10 am. Multiple entry points to the trail. Check winter map for details.	11 Miles
